High-level U.S. Science & Technology Delegation Visits HKUST

Science and technology officials of the U.S. government will visit the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology on 20 January (Friday) as the last stop on a one-week fact-finding tour of Asia.

The twelve-member delegation is headed by Dr John Gibbons, Science and Technology Advisor to the President. Key members include Dr Dan Goldin, Administrator of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, Dr Mary Good, Under Secretary for Technology, Department of Commerce, and Dr Neal Lane, Director of the National Science Foundation.

The delegation will be received by Professor Eugene Wong, Pro-Vice-Chancellor for Research & Development at HKUST, who will host a press conference for the delegates. The delegates will brief the press their views on the development of science and technology in China, Japan and Hong Kong.
