## Young Artists Reflect on Cultural Colonialism

As Hong Kong prepares for a new era in 1997, more than 20 young artists will unveil their reactions to cultural colonialism in a new exhibition opening at the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology on 20 November.

Every aspect of Hong Kong has been affected by its colonial history—from street names and architectural styles, to customs and culture. The exhibition will feature mixed-media works and innovative examples of installation art, enriched by a renewed sense of historical and local identity.

The exhibition is a co-presentation of the HKUST Center for the Arts and the Hong Kong Young Artists Association. Since 1992, the Association has organized a busy and challenging program, drawing on current affairs and using new technologies in its exhibitions and activities.
