ICES '92 Presents 4 Awards to Outstanding Scholars

The biennial International Conference on Computational Engineering Science, hosted by the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology and attended by about 400 scholars and experts from all over the world, successfully concluded on 22 December. Awards were presented to four scientists who have made outstanding contributions to the field.

The T.H.H. PIAN Medal was awarded to Dr Chang Chun Wu of the University of Science and Technology of China, Hefei, China, for his contributions to the development of finite element methodology.

Named to receive the ERIC REISSNER Medal was Dr Lallit Anand of M.I.T., for outstanding contributions to the mechanics of materials over the past decade.

Dr Masanori Kikuchi of the Science University of Tokyo received the K. WASHIZU Medal for his sustained contributions to the experimental, analytical, and computational mechanics of fracture of elastic-plastic structures.

The 1992 ICES Medal was awarded to Dr Satya N. Atluri of the Georgia Institute of Technology for his seminal contributions to computational engineering science and laudable service to the computational mechanics community.
