## New Art On-Line at HKUST

Art in cyberspace goes on-line at the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, when the exhibition, WebWise<>ArtsSites, opens on 21 March.

Multimedia arts from Germany and Britain created on CD-ROM, disk and the Internet will be set up on a bank of computers for visitors to explore and, in some cases, add their own artworks.

WebWise<>ArtSites is co-presented by the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, the [Goethe-Institut Hong Kong](#), the [British Council](#) and Transmedia/VideoFest, Berlin.

The exhibition will be opened by Prof Chia-Wei Woo, President of HKUST, Dr Uwe Nitschke, Director of the Goethe-Institut Hong Kong, and Mr Tom Buchanan, Director of the British Council in Hong Kong.
